College of Marin Hosts Transformation and Transportation Forum

KENTFIELD, Calif., March 11, 2006—The College of Marin will host a community forum titled *Transformation and Transportation: Campus at the Crossroads* exploring the impact of transportation on the College of Marin's Kentfield and Indian Valley campuses. The event will take place at 7PM, Wednesday, March 22, 2006, at Olney Hall. Faculty, staff, students and community members are invited to attend.

While conferences and meetings about transportation issues are commonplace, this forum is the first at which experts will examine the implications of the future development of the Kentfield and Indian Valley campuses. The event will be moderated by renowned architect Sim Van der Ryn, who is serving as the College of Marin's Director of the Center for Regenerative Design. Sim produced this forum as the first in a series. Community participation is invited after the presentations.
