BOND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE RELEASES ITS FIRST ANNUAL REPORT **Report features last year's planning activities and financial performance review**

KENTFIELD, Calif., April 26, 2006—The Marin Community College District Measure C Bond Citizens' Oversight Committee released its first annual report on activities related to the district's general obligation bond measure at the April 25 monthly meeting of the College of Marin Board of Trustees. The report features information about last year's facilities planning activities, including preconstruction planning, issuance of the AAA rated Series A bonds, selection of Swinerton Management and Consulting as the program manager for bond project activities, and a financial performance review of the first-year expenditures.

"Our committee is committed to meeting the expectations outlined in Proposition 39, to make certain that all funds are expended appropriately," said Measure C Bond Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee Chair, William J. Levinson, ED.D.

The Measure C Citizens' Oversight Committee was formed by the COM Board of Trustees on February 8, 2005. The committee is comprised of members representing a variety of constituent groups, including the business community, a senior citizen organization, taxpayers' association, college support organization, and the community at large.

Voters in Marin County approved Measure C on November 2, 2004 providing \$249.5 million in funding to update modernize, and retrofit the Marin Community College District serving County residents at the College of Marin Kentfield and Indian Valley Campuses.
