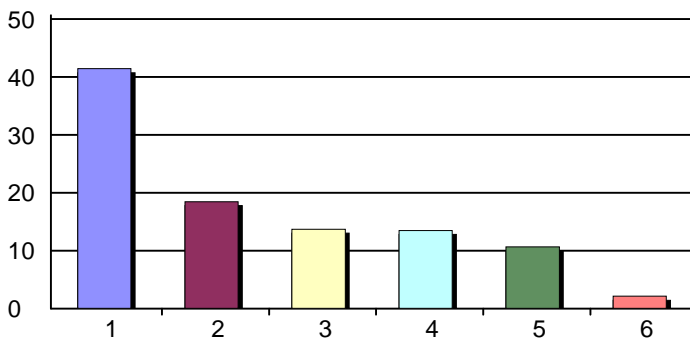

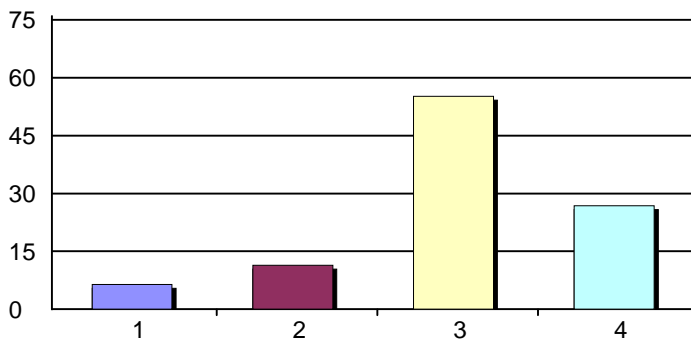

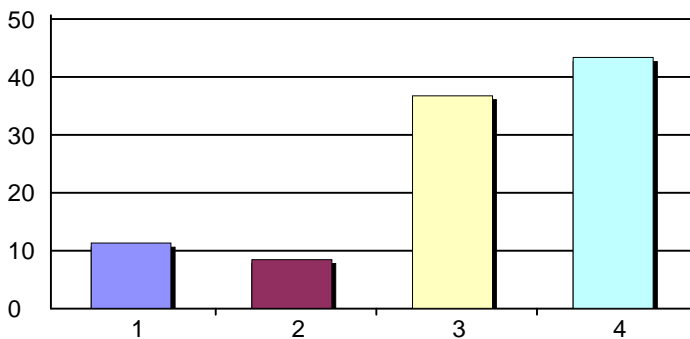

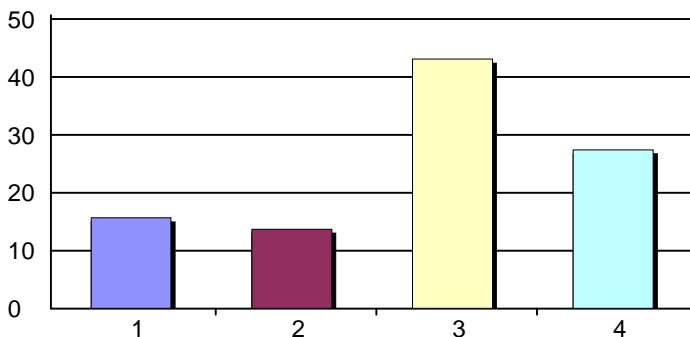

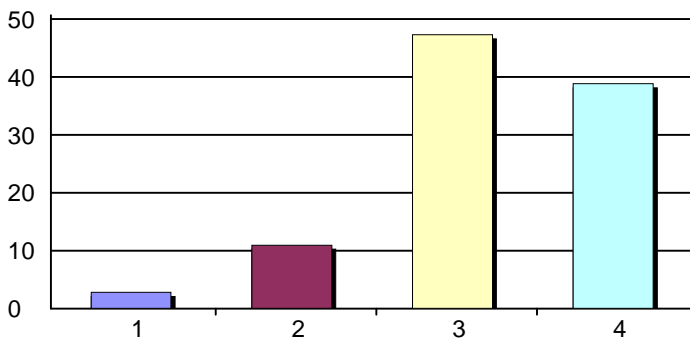

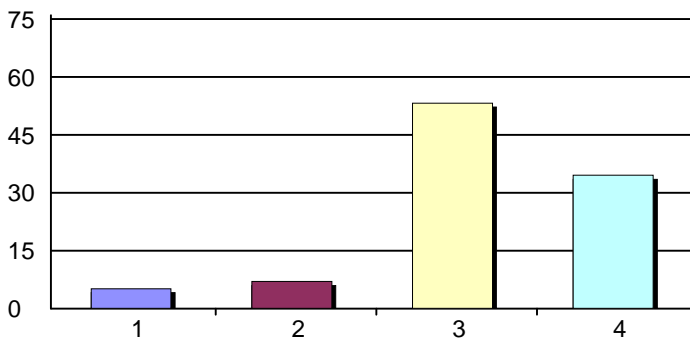

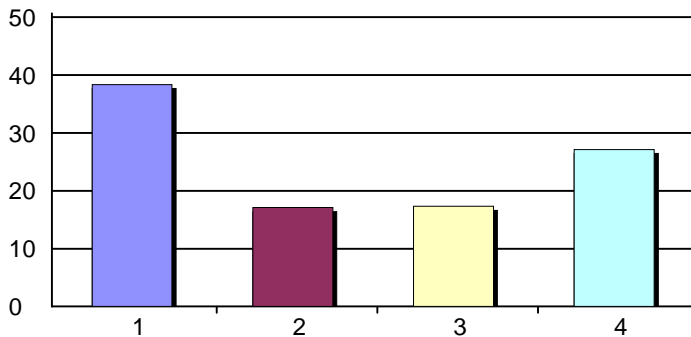
40. Childcare Center

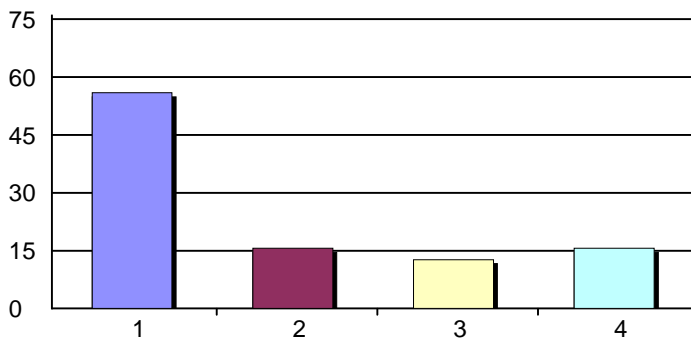
How likely is it that the following issues would cause you to withdraw from class or from College of Marin?

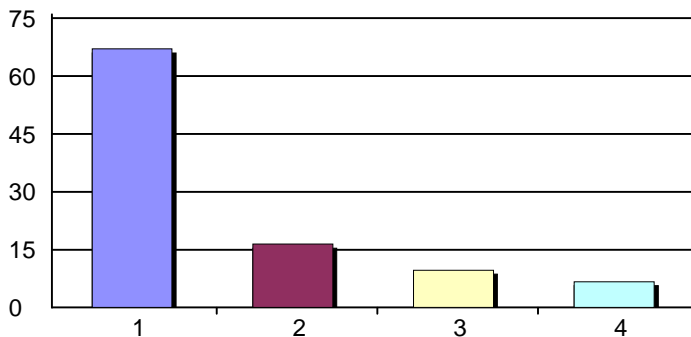

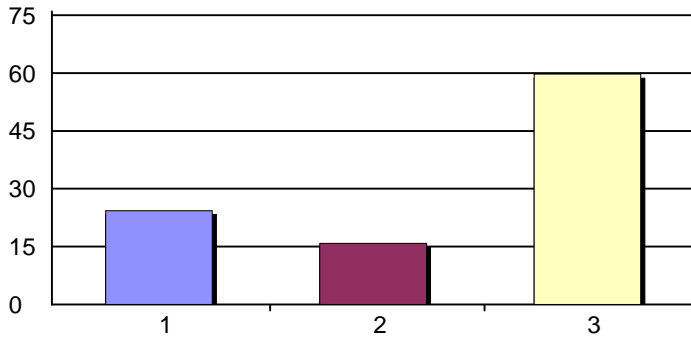

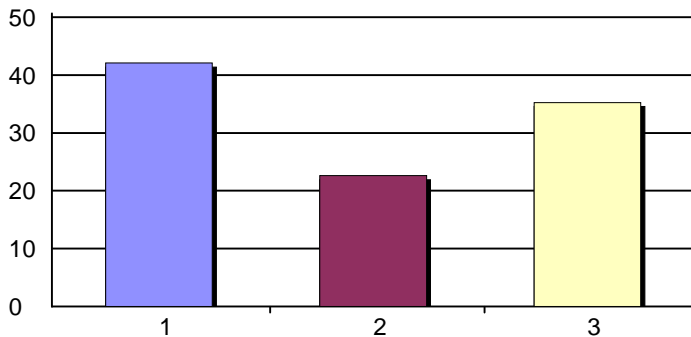
Which of the following are your reasons/goals for attending College of Marin?

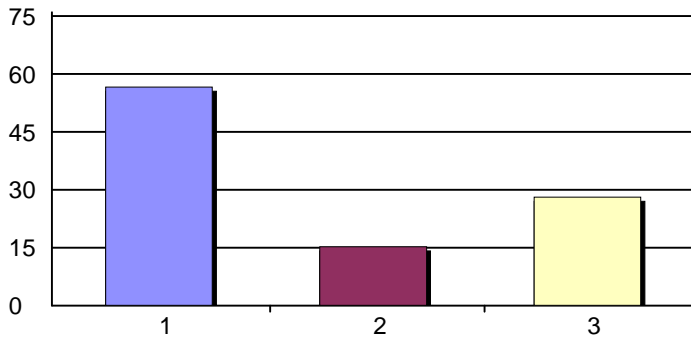
47. Obtain an associate degree

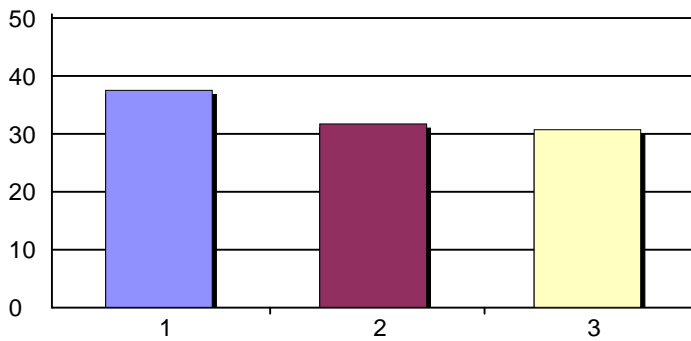

48. Transfer to a 4-year college or university



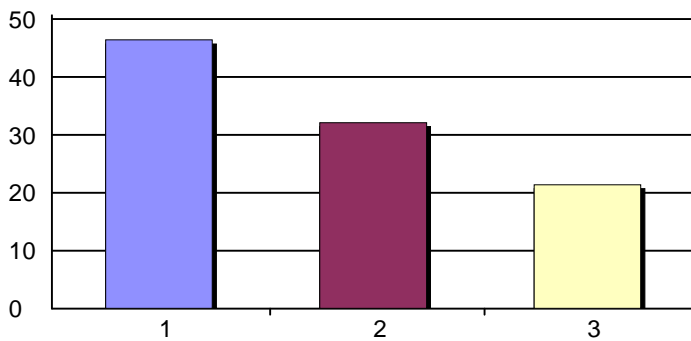

49. Obtain or update job-related skills



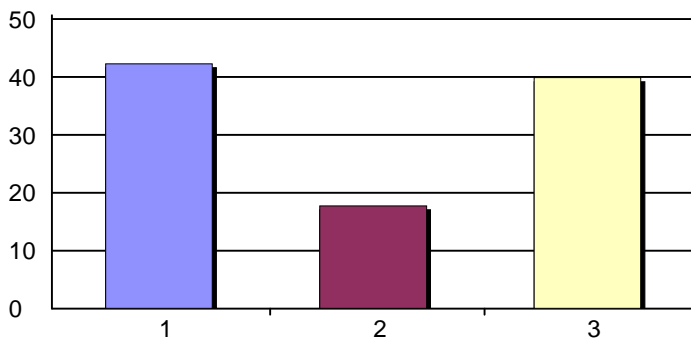

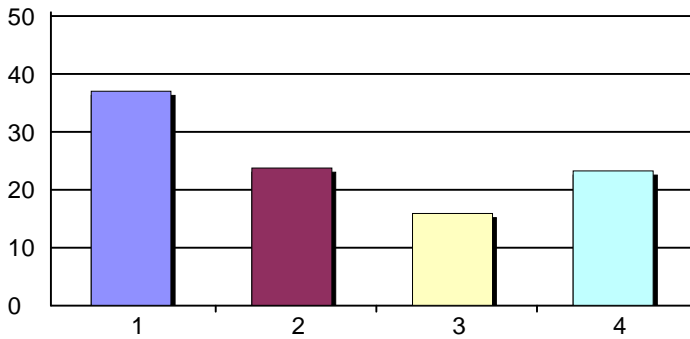
51. Change careers

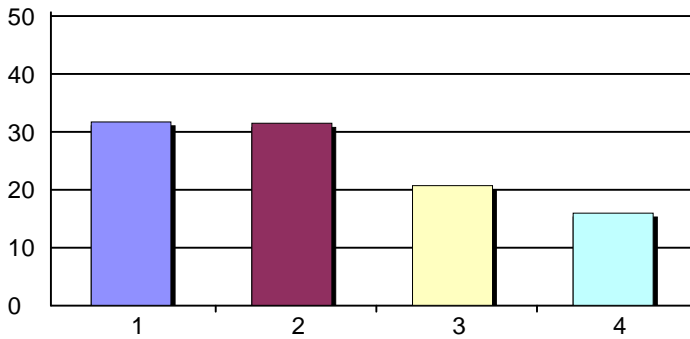

52. If public transportation is available to you with adequate schedules, how likely will you use it to commute to College of Marin?



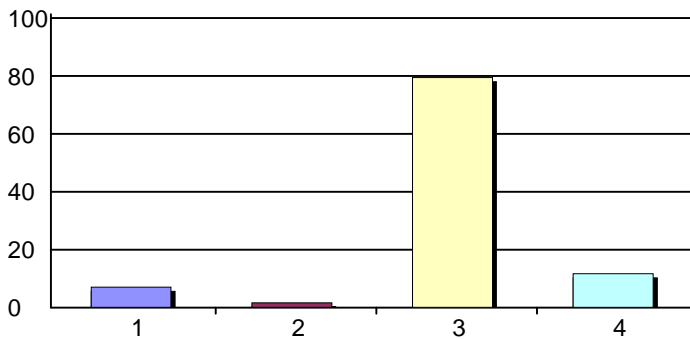

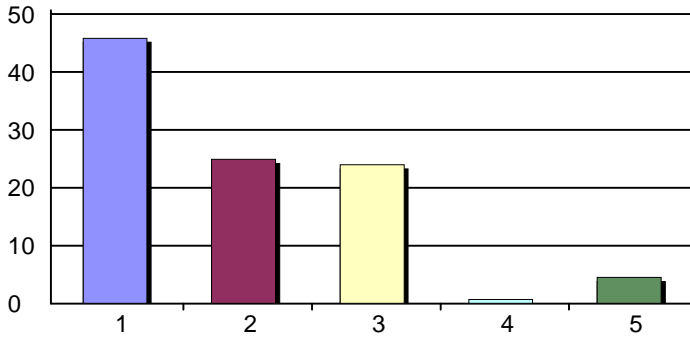

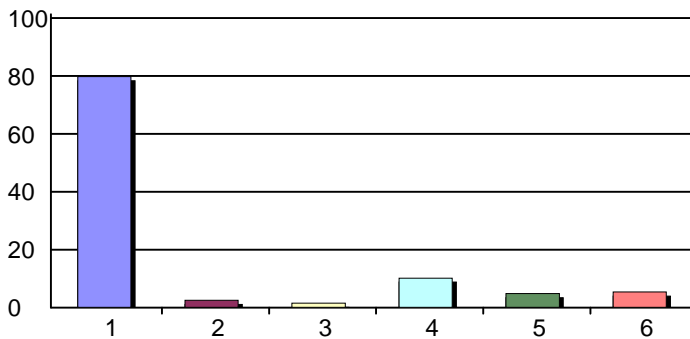

55. When do you most frequently take classes at College of Marin? (Mark one only)



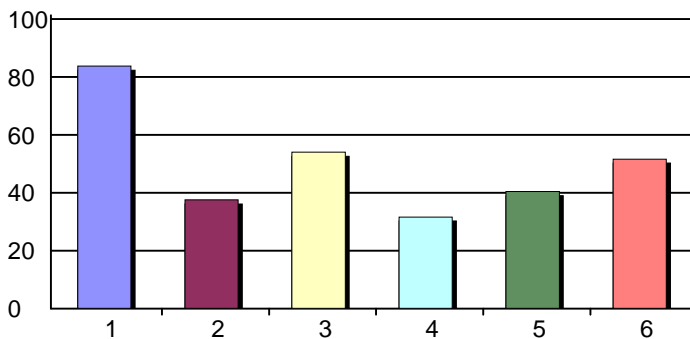

56. At what other types of institutions are you taking classes this term? (Please mark all that apply)



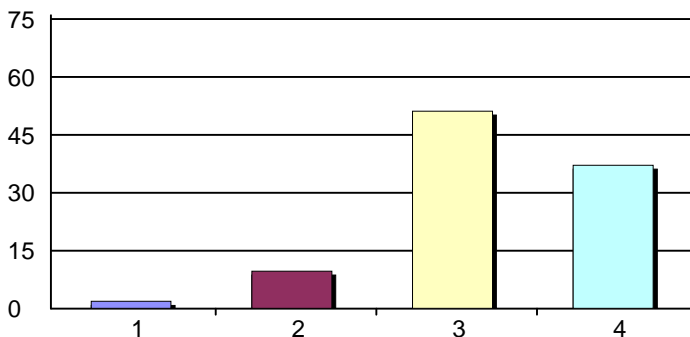

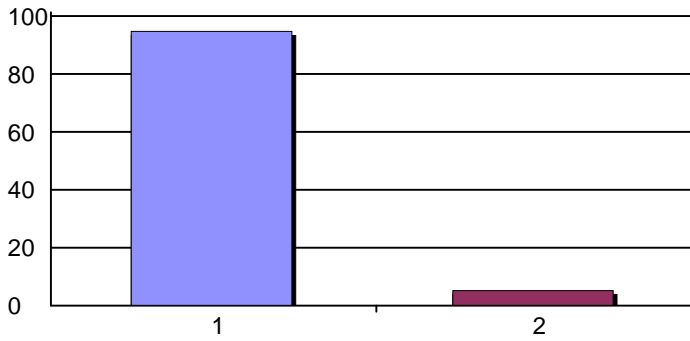
59. How would you evaluate your entire educational experience at College of Marin?

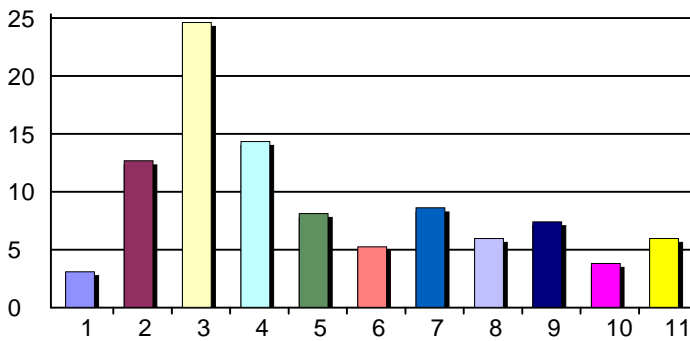

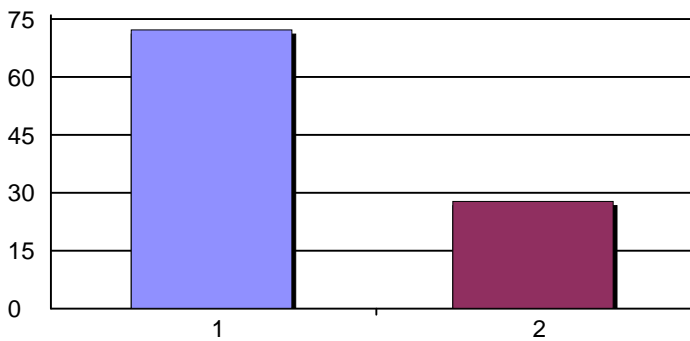

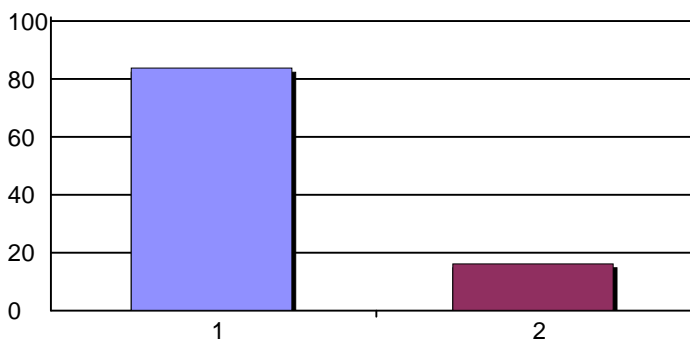

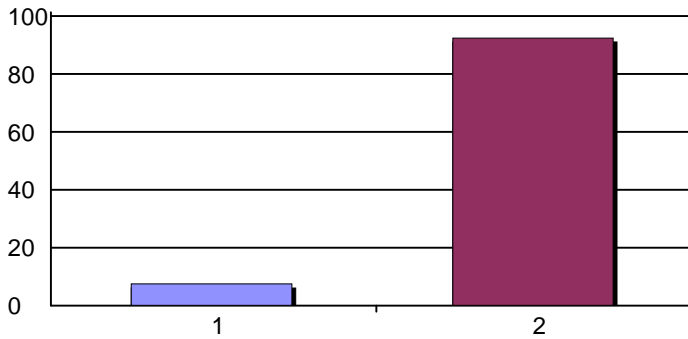

64. Are you an international student or foreign national?



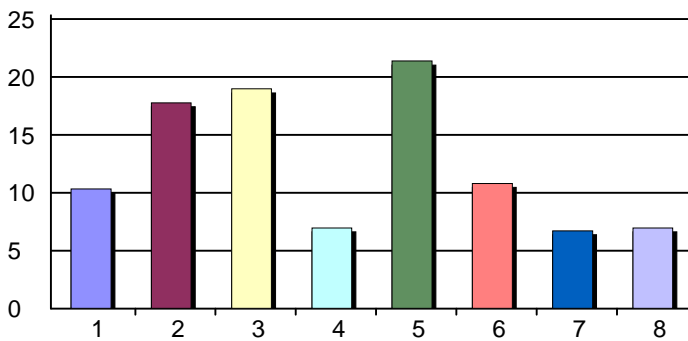

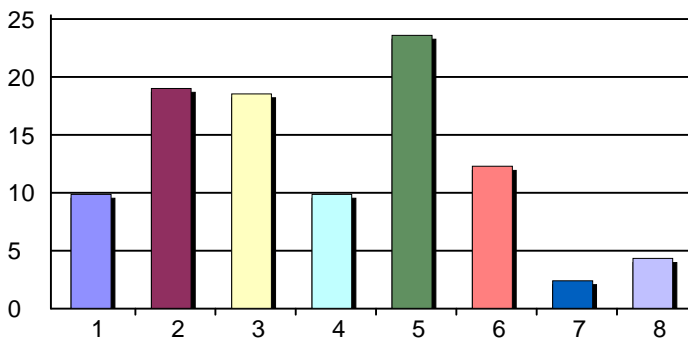
