Typical Coursework associated with the study of Physical Education

Programs in Physical Education are designed to prepare people for jobs in teaching, coaching, fitness management, or a combination of these areas. Programs may have emphases in aquatic sport, teaching, coaching, dance, pre-physical therapy, athletic training, sports medicine recreation, or commercial/industrial fitness. During freshman and sophomore years, Physical Education students usually take basic liberal arts and science courses, and some physical activity courses. These courses can be taken at a community college. During junior and senior years, students usually study human movement and physical education theory. Students in graduate programs usually specialize in one area of Physical Education.
